Kindergarten & 1st Grade

- 1 2-strap backpack (without wheels)

2nd and 3rd Grades School Supply List

Supplies left in good condition from last year are perfectly acceptable and are a thoughtful way to reuse and help the earth! **There is a \$20 charge for each student for additional classroom supplies.**

Classroom and supplies for individual students:

- Water bottle
- SCHOOL shoes that stay at school
- PE shoes that will stay in the gym
- pencil box labeled with your name
- plastic homework folder with 2 pockets
- 2 wide ruled composition books

Outdoor gear supplies for individual students: (*a note about quality: it matters! Your children will enjoy recess and field work more if they have gloves that don't absorb water, snow pants with elastic that holds them over their tail, waterproof boots. Please take your time acquiring this gear-- great resources for high quality affordable winter gear are the Durango Outdoor Exchange, ebay, and REI.com).

- Hat
- Gloves
- Winter coat with working zipper
- snow pants
- Snow boots
- In September, students will need a swimsuit, towel and swim goggles for the swim program
- In January, students will need skis, ski boots, helmet and goggles for the ski program

For the class:

- ALL students MUST purchase 1 box of 24 Ticonderoga pencils (seriously, they are the world's best and we must have them) . Students will turn those in the first week of school, and our class will share these throughout the year.

Optional items for individuals to purchase (I also have duplicates in the classroom, so it is not necessary that students purchase all of these items. Please do so only if it is financially possible and enjoyable for you and your child.)

- 4 Erasers
- 3 glue sticks
- 1 box of markers (Crayola are best)
- 1 box of colored pencils
- set of watercolors

To create uniformity and equanimity in our classroom, I will supply additional learning supplies for students including project folders, writing notebooks, art supplies, and practice workbooks.

Snacks: Students need a morning snack daily. Please know that you will need to pack something healthy each day or you are welcome to send a bag of pretzels and some peanut butter or a box of bars, etc. weekly so that your child has something to eat before they dive into some challenging math or have to focus on writing. Snacks with a lot of sugar, salt or fat do not belong in the classroom. I will hold on to that food until the end of the day and return it to your child for after school consumption. Examples include chips, Cheetos, cookies, chocolate milk, high sugar yogurts, gummy snacks, etc.

Welcome 4th & 5th grade students and parents!

We are about to start another fabulous school year and need to get geared up! Due to the need for specific supplies, I will purchase some of the key supplies for you. **The school is asking that you please bring \$20.00 to cover the cost of these items.** To give you an idea what your money is going towards, please check out the following list.
